To discontinue the proposal to introduce The Borough Of Dacorum (Bridgewater Road, Broadwater, Delahay Rise, Gaveston Drive, Trevelyan Way, Murray Road and New Road, Berkhamsted) (Restriction Of Waiting) Order 2012 and to advertise and make The Borough Of Dacorum (Broadwater, Berkhamsted) (Restriction Of Waiting) Order 2013.

Decision made and reasons:

To discontinue the proposal to introduce The Borough Of Dacorum (Bridgewater Road, Broadwater, Delahay Rise, Gaveston Drive, Trevelyan Way, Murray Road and New Road, Berkhamsted) (Restriction Of Waiting) Order 2012 and to advertise and make The Borough Of Dacorum (Broadwater, Berkhamsted) (Restriction Of Waiting) Order 2013.

The proposals were for the introduction of 11am to 12 noon "commuter ban" waiting restriction in Bridgewater Road, Broadwater, Delahay Rise, Gaveston Drive, Trevelyan Way, Murray Road and New Road. For safety reasons the proposals also included some no waiting at any time restrictions. The proposed restrictions were to discourage inappropriate parking by commuters and to improve the safety of road users and pedestrians.

The decision to discontinue any progression to the schemes with the exception of Broadwater is at the request of Berkhamsted Town Council.

A new Traffic Order will be required for Broadwater.

Residents have been consulted as part of the process to introduce the discontinued proposed Borough Of Dacorum (Bridgewater Road, Broadwater, Delahay Rise, Gaveston Drive, Trevelyan Way, Murray Road and New Road, Berkhamsted) (Restriction Of Waiting) Order 2012.

Monitoring Officer Comments:

As Berkhamsted Town Council were the sponsors for the proposed restriction of waiting order and have now withdrawn its support for the proposals the Council could be the subject of legal challenge if it continued to implement the Order

Deputy S151 Officer Comments:

The costs of implementing this decision can be absorbed within the Council's existing budget.

Implications:

Inappropriate parking in Bridgewater Road, Delahay Rise, Gaveston Drive, Trevelyan Way, Murray Road and New Road these areas will continue.

Risk:

The intention of this decision is to comply with DBC procedures.

Value for Money:

The on-street parking service is not designed to produce any income, but, in line with government guidelines, to be self-financing.

All consultation costs were met by Berkhamsted Town Council.

Dacorum Borough Council will bear the costs for advertising, signing and lining the Borough Of Dacorum (Broadwater, Berkhamsted) (Restriction Of Waiting) Order 2013 which are estimated to be below £1,000.
