Supported Housing Scheme

Supported housing is accommodation for people who are aged 60 and over, who can live on their own but who would like to have support close by.

We have 33 supported housing schemes across Dacorum with a range of self-contained flats and bungalows. Social gatherings and activities are often available within these schemes.

Emma Rothschild Court in Tring, is a purpose built supported scheme.

Where is Emma Rothschild Court?

Emma Rothschild Court is off Silk Mill Way in Tring. There is a small supermarket nearby and other shops, restaurants and the library nearby on the high street.

The nearest doctors' surgery is The New Surgery, which is about 15 minutes' walk away on Tring High Street.

How many flats are there?

There are 38 self-contained flats in the scheme.

What facilities are there?

Emma Rothschild Court is a 2 storey building in Tring. There is a lift to the upper floor. There is a laundry, communal lounge, guest room, hairdressing room and sun terrace for tenants to use.

What activities do other tenants participate in?

Tenants meet up for coffee mornings and to play darts, cards and bingo regularly. There is an Age UK group that arranges friendship teas and barbecues. We also run tablet courses to help

tenants get online as part of our **Tenant Academy**, and a range of other free courses are available.
