

**Clarification Statement from Mrs. B. Mariner concerning  
Issue 11: Berkhamsted**

Dear Mr Kemp,

Following this mornings meeting I am writing to clarify a point I raised. At the time I could not recall the exact reference to a point in the Council document and Mr Hogger asked me to send this on to clarify the point.

The item is on the Issue 10 Hearing Statement - Dacorum Borough Council. It appears on page 13 of 30 under 10.1.45. It seems to contradict what the Council had said elsewhere about the timetable for using the Green Belt sites, in particular the field at the Old Town (between Cherry Bounce and Fletcher Way). It shows the field as second in priority although other documents state a lower priority and a period of at least ten years before the field is used.

Also, I did turn up my card to make a point but the discussion had moved on. The field in LA2, although steeply sloped is used informally for sports. Local children play cricket on the flat area at the top and the field is well used in the snow for tobogganing.

Thank you for allowing me this opportunity to clarify the reference.
