



## Corrections Schedule

*The following corrections have been made to the original papers prepared by the Council. They correct typographical errors, further explain a point or improve the clarity of the Council's response.*

### Issue 13: Kings Langley

Paragraph	Correction
13.1.13	<p><i>Penultimate sentence</i></p> <p>The Council and Three Rivers Council will be guided by HCC on primary provision, the current conclusions is that an additional school in the south of Hemel Hempstead would be sufficient to meet all relevant needs.<sup>1</sup></p> <p><sup>1</sup> <u>This is separate from provision which may also be needed in Three Rivers district in the Bedmond/Abbots Langley/Leavesden area</u></p>
13.2.25	<p>Kings Langley is a relatively large village, with a population of around 4,000 people (<u>in Dacorum</u>). It straddles the boundary of Dacorum Borough and Three Rivers District and has a strong relationship with Abbots Langley (in Three Rivers) which it adjoins.<sup>1</sup></p> <p><sup>1</sup> <u>The population of the full settlement was 4,942 people in 2001 (2001 census statistics supplied by Hertfordshire County Council).</u></p>
13.3.5	<p><i>Penultimate sentence</i></p> <p>This will free up places at Kings Langley <u>Primary</u> School for village residents.</p>
