BACKGROUND

In 2003 the Borough of Dacorum (Berkhamsted) Prohibition of Waiting (Consolidation) Order 2003 was enacted.

An appeal against a penalty charge notice has brought to light a typographical error to schedule 5 of the above Order.

The waiting restrictions on this section of road can no longer be enforced.

Enforcement cannot recommence until the replacement Order is enacted

The effect of the Order would be to correct a typographic error in Schedule 5 of The Dacorum Borough Council (Berkhamsted) Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting (Consolidation) Order 2003.

The Order makes no material changes to the waiting restriction as indicated by lines and signs currently in place.

The final consultation process did not generate any objections
