(No. 2) (England) Order 2008

Came into force 1st October 2008

**The installation, alteration or replacement of a microwave antenna on a
dwellinghouse or within its cartilage.**

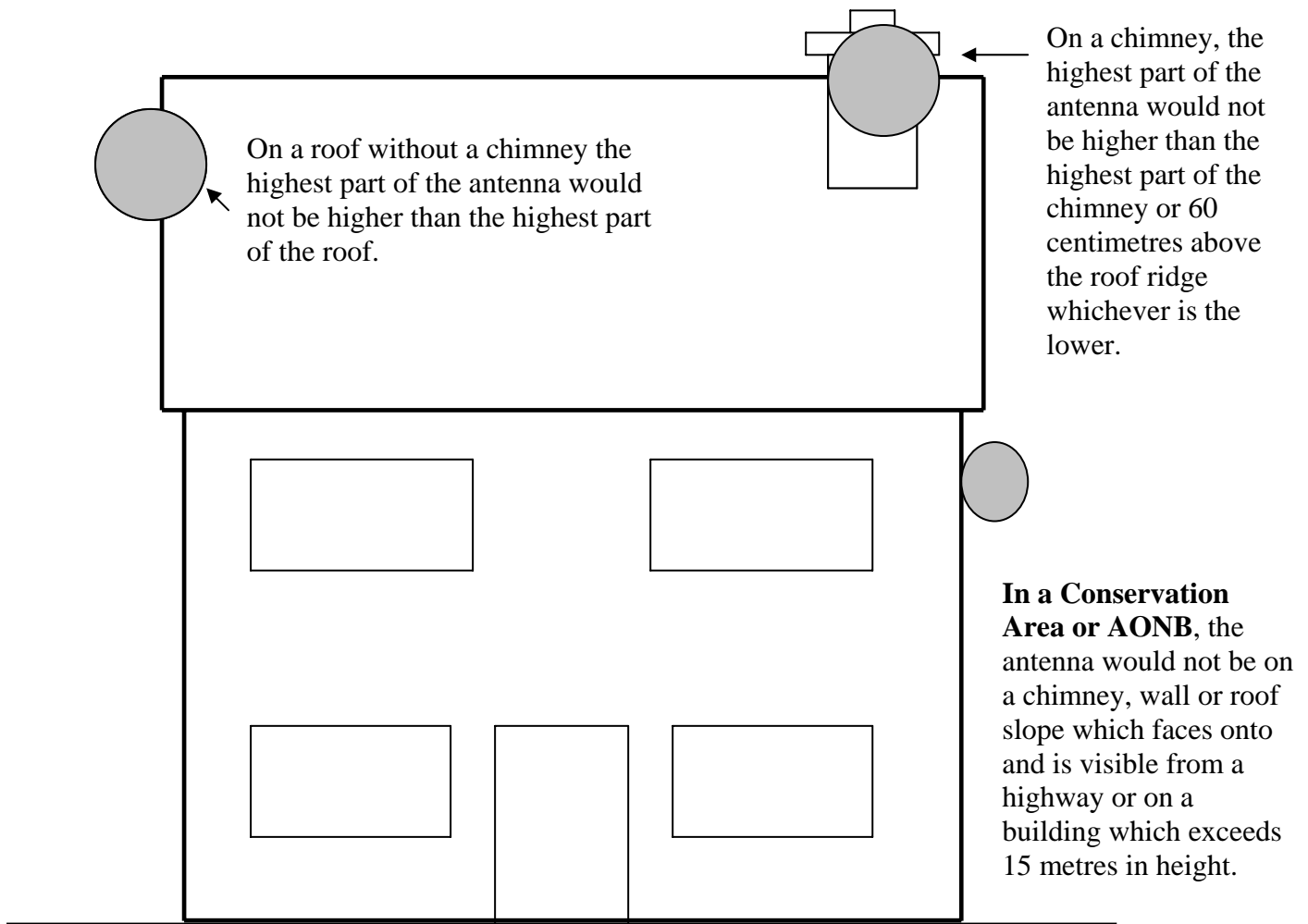


Part 1, Class H

The installation, alteration or replacement of a microwave antenna on a dwellinghouse or within its curtilage.

Permitted development provided that:-

- Not more than two antennas
- One antenna not more than 100 centimetres in length
- Second antenna not more than 60 centimetres in length
- The cubic capacity of any antenna would not exceed 35 litres.



Conditions:-

- An antenna installed on a building shall, as far as practicable, be sited so as to minimise its effect on the external appearance of the building, and
- An antenna no longer needed for reception or transmission purposes shall be removed as soon as reasonably practicable.

Note : This should not be taken as a definitive interpretation of the relevant provisions of the Town and Country Planning legislation but used only as general guidance.
