Kings Langley Neighbourhood Planning Referendum

1. A referendum will be held on **Thursday 17 November 2022** to decide on the question below:

Do you want Dacorum Borough Council to use the neighbourhood plan for Kings Langley Parish to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?

2. The hours of poll will be from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.
3. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at The Forum, Marlowes, Hemel Hempstead, HP1 1DN by 5 p.m. on Wednesday 2 November 2022
4. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at The Forum, Marlowes, Hemel Hempstead, HP1 1DN by 5 p.m. on Wednesday 9 November 2022
5. Applications to vote by proxy at this election applied for on grounds of physical incapacity, where that physical incapacity occurred after 5 p.m. on Wednesday 9 November 2022 must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5 p.m. on 17 November 2022.
