Public/Products Liability - Policy No: PLON99/0067935 Indemnity to the Insured for legal liability for damages and legal costs arising out of third party injury, loss or damage, in connection only with activities controlled/sponsored/recognised/authorised by The Amateur Boxing Association of England Ltd and notified to the insurers during the Period of Insurance. # **Hemel Hempstead Boxing Club**

Formal 'Expression of Interest' to take over the vacant premises at Queens Square Adeyfield as a Community gym and Amateur Boxing training facility for the benefit of local communities and Hemel Hempstead in general

## Introduction:

Amateur Boxing has and is recognised as a long established and proven form of training and exercise. Also on the back of the 2008 Olympics success and the 2012 Olympics in London only 2 years away, there is an interest at grass roots level within the community as well as at the regional and national level which is being supported across the political and sports spectrum.

It has been shown in many parts of the UK and over many years that a properly run boxing club situated in the right area can provide a diversion away from crime and anti social behavior and provides a focal point for encouraging young people into a healthier and fitter life style. This is a statement of fact.

This club is unique in being the only registered Amateur Boxing Club in Dacorum Borough and Hemel Hempstead area.

Having a permanent facility will help the club achieve its stated objectives but can also be shared with a number of other community agencies and build on the partnerships that are already at a green shoot stage. Examples – Schools, World shapers, Police and special interest groups such as Asian women's boxing.

#### **Club Status:**

On the 14<sup>th</sup> January 2008 Hemel Hempstead Boxing Club was formally constituted as follows:

- Committee formed
- Club Rules accepted
- Club Aims agreed
- Club bank account opened
- Club membership program set up
- Affiliation to the ABA of England via the Home Counties ABA and registered
- Program for sponsorship and grants started
- Working relationship with DBC Officers and Councilors established
- Community links established
- Club ethos 'non profit making' and staffed with volunteers

#### **Current Situation:**

Although we have the use of the Bennett's End Youth Centre, which is functional, it is not a boxing gym as we are unable to put up our equipment properly. This has now become a major issue in the recruitment and retainment of the young people's interest. Also we are limited on times of use which has made it difficult to structure programs for juniors and seniors as well as causing a problem for coaches due to early start times.

It also means that the potential recruits as well as current amateur boxers who live in Hemel will continue to go out of the area to St. Albans, Watford and Luton to train and box which is depriving this town of sporting success and the youth of Hemel in general of a sports facility that is recognised as an Olympic sport.

### What Needs to Happen Next?

The club is in urgent need of a permanent base so it can:

- Establish a boxing centre of excellence
- Put up the equipment on a full time basis
- Structure the opening times to suit the members and coaches
- Create dedicated programs for beginners, single sex, juniors, seniors and competition boxers
- Assist the local council, police and courts with referral initiatives for youth offenders
- Become a leading community youth sport initiative on a par with HH football, HH rugby and HH cricket, etc
- Achieve the club aims at stated below

The Adeyfield facility would allow the club to put into action its short and medium term plans and would be an ideal venue:

- Central to the Adeyfield community but also reasonably easy to get to for most Hemel based youths
- Use of facility can be extended to local police and council youth departments
- Shops and parking nearby
- Gym would be in use most afternoons through to mid evening during the week with some day time week end opening as well
- Building shell is sound and floor space would be fit for purpose, Although we understand there is a structural concern on part of the roof

#### **Club Aims:**

- To establish a Centre for Amateur Boxing Excellence within the Hemel Hempstead Community, with a fully functioning gym and ABA approved coaches
- To offer constructive activity, social inclusion, multi cultural environment and community integration for the youth of Hemel Hempstead who express an interest in Amateur Boxing and all it has to offer
- To Train and Coach selected club members to National ABA Competition standard and produce an Olympic hopeful for the 2012 Games in London

#### What We Can Offer:

- Tuition from ABA licensed and accredited coaches who are CRB approved and First aid certified
- Experienced coaches with track record of success in regional and national competitions
- Structured training for novice through to senior level (male and female)
- Fun, safe and disciplined environment with strong team ethic

### **Next Steps:**

We would welcome the opportunity to discuss our interest further and present our case in more detail.

Let's give this community and town a facility they can be proud of, which with DBC support and our dedication we can achieve together.

"The ASB Team have been involved with this boxing club from the very beginning as a member of the team started the club in January 2006 with a non-contact 'Urban Fitness' club. It was immediately clear that there was a demand for a boxing club in the area and the club grew and grew to a point where in 2007, volunteers from Hemel Hempstead Boxing Club came on board. The club is hosted by Bennetts End Youth Club but it is not possible for the club to set up a ring and other heavy equipment due to the shared use and lack of space.

Publicity has been restricted as are the number of young people who are able to attend this project due to the lack of space and time at Bennetts End Youth Club – especially the inability to erect a boxing ring. The club meets a real need in Hemel Hempstead and if the club have their own building the potential of the club can be realised.

The ASB Team, Specialist Adolescence Team and Youth Offending Team have all referred young people to this project over the last few years which provides 3 free training sessions per week to young people from all backgrounds and cultures – this really is a cohesive project which would benefit the wider community should it have its own base and it is intended that young people will continue to access the project free of charge."
