



Lagley House and Douglas Gardens

Supported Housing Scheme

Supported housing is accommodation for people who are aged 60 and over, who can live on their own but who would like to have support close by.

We have 33 supported housing schemes across Dacorum with a range of self-contained flats and bungalows. Social gatherings and activities are often available within these schemes.

Lagley House and Douglas Gardens in Berkhamsted, is a purpose built supported scheme.

Where is Cranford?

This is a 2 building scheme, with both sides easy to get to by car. It is located in Gossoms End, Berkhamsted. There is a walkway in between the 2 buildings.

The nearest doctors' surgery is Gossoms End Surgery, which is about five minutes' walk away. The scheme is also very close to Berkhamsted Sports Centre, which have a swimming pool and a range of activities from gentle exercise to more strenuous fitness classes.

How many flats are there?

There are 28 self-contained flats, with an additional 25 bungalows in Douglas Gardens.

What facilities are there?

There are two communal kitchens, a communal lounge and conservatory, as well as a laundry for tenants' use. There are also two scooter sheds, assisted bathroom, hair dressers room, communal toilets for visitors. There is a mixture of both flats inside the scheme and bungalows on the outside at Douglas Gardens.

What activities do other tenants participate in?

We have had several winners of the garden competitions in the past. We also have various activities coordinated by outside agencies. Residents try to run events including day trips,

and fish and chip suppers. We also run tablet courses to help tenants get online as part of our **Tenant Academy**, and a range of other free courses are available.
