Supported Housing Scheme

Supported housing is accommodation for people who are aged 60 and over, who can live on their own but who would like to have support close by.

We have 33 supported housing schemes across Dacorum with a range of self-contained flats and bungalows. Social gatherings and activities are often available within these schemes.

Oaklawn in Tring, is a purpose built supported scheme.

Where is Oaklawn?

Oaklawn Supported Housing Scheme is off Akeman Street in Tring, the scheme is a short walk to Tring High Street, local shops and the library.

The nearest doctors' surgery is Rothschild House Surgery, which is less than 15 minutes' walk away.

How many flats are there?

There are 22 flats in the scheme.

What facilities are there?

There are two communal lounges and a laundry for tenants to use. The scheme also has a well-kept communal garden. There is a small car park and a guest room, which can be booked for overnight visitors. The scheme also has a pool table and dart board in one of the lounges.

What activities do other tenants participate in?

This scheme has regular coffee mornings on Tuesdays and Fridays. The tenants are a welcoming community who organise days out and events such as fish and chip suppers. They also play bingo regularly. We also run tablet courses to help tenants get online as part of our **Tenant Academy**, and a range of other free courses are available.
