- All children will be treated with equal respect, recognising individual children have individual needs and we will adapt the way we work and make adjustments to make sure that we meet those needs. We will teach children to value themselves and to respect others.
- We aim to provide a high quality out of schools play provision for all children and families at the Adventure playgrounds.
