General:	We feel the existing conditions are adequate with no additional measures deemed necessary.
Prevention of crime and disorder:	<p>Existing conditions:</p> <p>1.1 CCTV shall be provided on the premises, with cameras located to show the front of the premises, kitchen, till area and staff entry, that shall provide frontal ID in any light condition. Recordings shall be kept for 31 days, and shall be made immediately available to Police or an authorised officer upon request. A responsible person who can download the images shall always be on the premises.</p> <p>1.2. Notices shall be displayed to clearly show that CCTV monitoring is taking place.</p> <p>1.3. An incident log book shall be maintained, recording any significant incidents of disorder that take place. This book shall be available for inspection by Police or an authorised officer.</p> <p>1.4. A list of emergency services numbers shall be kept on the premises.</p>
Public safety:	<p>Existing conditions</p> <p>2.1 A Fire alarm and extinguisher shall be clearly located at the premises.</p> <p>2.2 There shall be safety signage displayed.</p> <p>2.3. A policy shall be put in place to ensure that the agreed safe limit of five persons in the premises at any time, including staff and customers, is not exceeded.</p>
Prevention of public nuisance:	<p>Existing conditions</p> <p>3.1 Notices shall be displayed asking customers to leave the premises quietly.</p> <p>3.2. Ventilation and extractions systems shall be maintained to minimise noxious smells in the immediate vicinity of the premises.</p> <p>3.3. Neither waste disposal nor deliveries shall take place after 23.00.</p>
Protection of children from harm:	<p>Existing conditions:</p> <p>4.1 No alcohol shall be served at the premises.</p> <p>4.2 Entry to the kitchen area by the public shall be prohibited.</p> <p>4.3. All children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult after 21.00.</p>
