Dacorum Borough Council has received an application for a **Pavement Licence**, relating to the premises detailed above. If granted, this would allow the business to place removable furniture upon the public highway adjacent to this premises for the purposes of selling, serving or enabling the consumption of food and drink, for a temporary period expiring on the 30th September 2022.

Any licences granted will be subject to conditions requiring an appropriate width of pavement to be left clear for pedestrian and wheelchair access, preventing the obstruction of vehicular traffic, and requiring business to ensure appropriate social distancing measures, amongst other requirements. Licences may be revoked if businesses fail to adhere to these conditions.
