



Corrections Schedule

The following corrections have been made to the original papers prepared by the Council. They correct typographical errors, further explain a point or improve the clarity of the Council's response.

Issue 10: Hemel Hempstead

Paragraph	Correction
10.1.42	<i>Last sentence</i> Although this consultation document was <u>published and</u> subject to sustainability appraisal, <u>the alternative growth scenarios it contained were not subject to general public</u> it was never published for consultation due to the successful High Court Challenge.
10.1.45	<i>First sentence</i> Following the legal challenge decision, the <u>The</u> Council carried out a detailed assessment of smaller scale potential locations at Hemel Hempstead and elsewhere in the Borough.
10.1.47	<i>Second bullet point: add references</i> Sustainability Appraisal Working Notes and Draft Sustainability Appraisal Report produced in conjunction with the Core Strategy consultation documents. <u>(Examination Document CS19 provides a compendium)</u>
10.3.16	<i>Last sentence</i> In the event, the site was deleted, because the Council decided that its preference was for development on the Manor Estate in Hemel Hempstead (site TWA4 on page 379 of the adopted Local Plan – Examination Document OT1) <u>and that it did not need any of the [LA3] area to meet the housing target to 2011.</u>
10.3.21	<i>LA3 Principle 4 penultimate sentence</i> Traffic modelling undertaken by the Council <u>and by the landowners</u> has shown that the impact on the highway <u>network</u> would be reasonable.
